WEST MIDLANDS POLICE AND CRIME PANEL REPORT ON THE PROPOSED PRECEPT 2013/14

Introduction

In accordance with Schedule 5 of the Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011 the Panel must review the proposed precept and make a report to the PCC on the proposed precept

On 6 February 2013 the West Midlands Police and Crime Panel considered the Commissioner's proposed precept.

Commissioner's Proposed Precept

To increase the precept for 2013/14 by 3%, setting the Band D precept at £102.43.

Members Present:

Cllrs Cooper, Phillips, Meeson, Sparkes, Alden, Smith, Duggins and Bains and Lionel Walker. Cllr Sleigh was present prior to Cllr Meeson's arrival.

Panel Decision

- a) The Panel supports the precept and makes the following recommendations:
- The Panel would like more detail provided to it on the PCC Capital Programme 2013/14 2016/17 (sections 1, 2 and 3).
- The Panel welcomes the transfer of community safety grants to the districts as promised, but would like further detail regarding these. The Panel also notes the PCC's commitment that this year's cut does not set a precedent for community safety activity taking the brunt of funding cuts in the future.
- The Panel requests an ongoing discussion about adjusting the balance of precept / grant income in the overall budget.
- The Panel considers that the balance of pressure against the precept and the reserves is incorrect and that the PCC should have considered greater use of reserves.
- The Panel is concerned that further changes, which Members will not be able to then consider, could be made following the Partnership Summit on Friday.
