**WEST MIDLANDS POLICE AND CRIME PANEL REPORT ON THE PROPOSED PRECEPT
2020/2021**

1. Introduction

In accordance with Schedule 5 of the Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011 the Panel must review the proposed precept and make a report to the West Midlands Police and Crime Commissioner.

On 3 February 2020, the West Midlands Police and Crime Panel considered the Commissioner's proposed precept for 2020/2021.

2. Commissioner's Proposed Precept 2020/2021

The Police and Crime Commissioner proposed that the Band D precept for 2020/21 should be set at **£162.55** an increase of £10 compared to 2019/20.
